MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF OCTOBER 10, 2007

The Zoning and Planning Commission of the Village of Galena met on Wednesday October 10, 2007 in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building at 9 West Columbus Street, Galena, Ohio. Present were members; President Tom Hopper, Nancy Feole, Denny Morris and Stan Swisher. Also present were Zoning Inspector David LaValle and Zoning Clerk Sally Hopper. Member Mark Brooks was absent. The meeting was officially called to order at 7:03 PM.

Copies of the minutes from the last meeting of September 12, 2007 had been distributed to all members by the Clerk. A motion to approve the minutes, with a spelling correction, was made by Nancy Feole, seconded by Denny Morris and passed unanimously.

Zoning Inspector David LaValle had issued a written report which is attached and incorporated as part of these minutes. He has sent a bill to Homewood for a broken streetlight in the Estates at Blackhawk subdivision. He is working on getting a phone line installed into the Walnut Creek lift station. It was not installed when the station was built under Delaware County inspection. He updated the Commission and answered questions concerning the Homewood rezoning of the Miller Farm project. He also updated them on the ODNR trails grant money for the Kane's Crossing land purchase.

The Clerk had nothing additional to report.
